## 1. PRESENTATION BY DR. MICHAEL CROW, PRESIDENT OF ARIZONA STATE UNIVERSITY, REGARDING HEALTH URBAN ENVIRONMENT.

Members of both the Authority and the Supervisors met in a joint meeting for a presentation by President Crow regarding the issues Maricopa County faces regarding heat and air quality.

President Crow referred to a solution-focused research, policy and technology incubator through Arizona State University ("ASU") called the Healthy Urban

Environments ("HUE"), which has been designed to test, develop and deploy heat mitigation and air-quality improvement strategies and technologies in collaboration with others in order to create a healthy city and population across Maricopa County.

Dr. Charles Redman and Dr. Matt Fraser, professors at ASU, were also in attendance and joined in the discussion.

Dr. Crow said it is important for the entire community to come together to find solutions to improve the quality of life for our unique and fast growing county.
